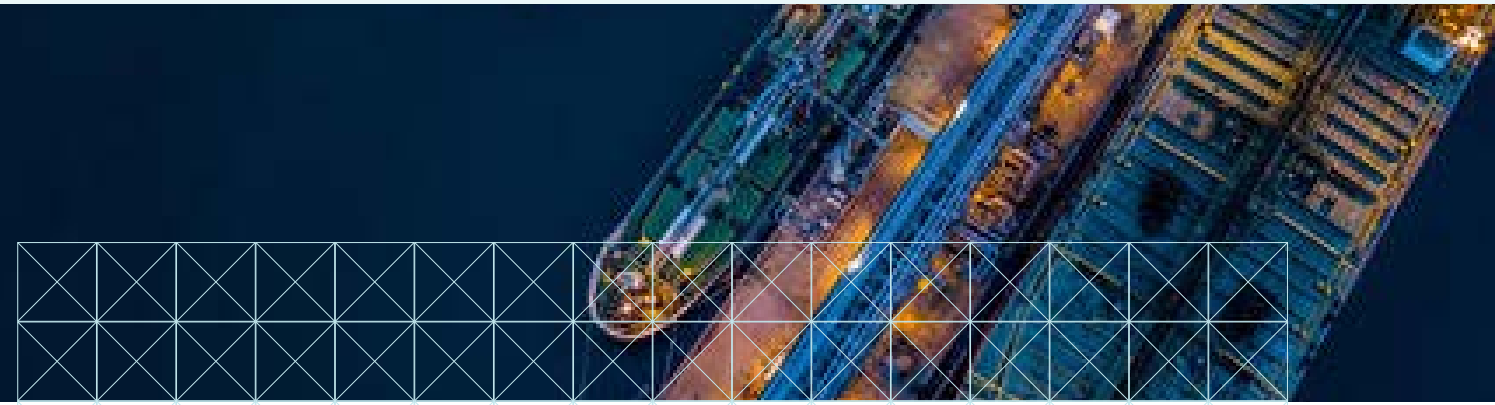

COURSE DESCRIPTION

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

This course aim to provide:

- Knowledge relating to STS operation elements in general, with special focus on safety for crew, vessel and environment
- Compliance with Company Policies and Procedures relating to STS operations underway, at anchor and in port
- Obtain knowledge and skill to observe, evaluate, decide and act on unwanted operational incidents

TARGET GROUP

Masters and Chief Officers occasionally or regularly participating in STS Operations.

In service as Master or Deck officer at management level.

Participants knowledge and skill will be formally assessed at the end of the course.
