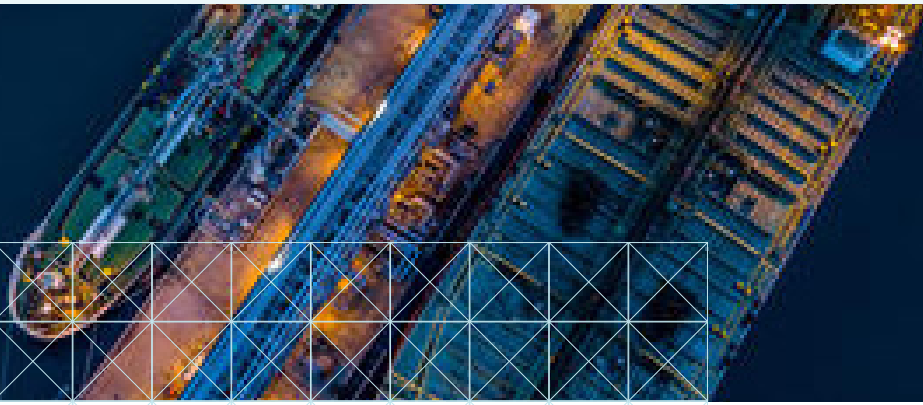

- Observations and monitoring during approach
- Mooring Master condition
- Communication
- Forces to handle during approach
- Time frames available during final approach
- Handling of unwanted incidents
- Action priorities
- Analysing unwanted incidents
- Exercises: 1-10 STS underway/at anchor/Berthed

#### LEARNING PROCESS

The course consists of totally tree theoretical lessons and ten selected simulator exercises.

Participant learning progress assessed by concurrent evaluation during both theory sessions and simulator exercises.
